Category Criteria

- The Sustainability Award is open to any company with a manufacturing base predominantly in Northern Ireland. This award aims to highlight food and drink companies that have initiated projects to enhance sustainability and reduce their environmental footprint.
- The award is targeted at companies of all sizes who have launched initiatives to reduce their impact on the planet, by making processes and products more sustainable.

Judging Process

The award is open to any Northern Ireland agri-food business, industry representative body or group of businesses.

The judges are looking for innovative organisations that have initiated projects to enhance sustainability and reduce their environmental footprint.

The deadline for completed applications is **Thursday 8th February 2024**.
