Category Criteria

The DAERA Agri-Food Supply Chain Excellence Award, is open to any Northern Ireland agri-food business or group of businesses that can demonstrate **the creation or improvement of supply chain linkages that have delivered clear benefit to producers.**

The judges will look for innovative initiatives that show co-operation with supply chain partners.

Judging Process

The award is open to any Northern Ireland agri-food business, industry representative body or group of businesses.

The judges will look for innovative initiatives (projects/events/activities) that have created or improved supply chain linkages and increased cooperation and collaboration along the supply chain to deliver clear benefits to producers.

The deadline for completed applications is **Thursday 8th February 2024.**

Questions

Question 1. Identify and describe the sustainable supply chain linkages that the project/event/activity has created or improved, highlighting aspects you consider innovative. (10 Marks)

Question 2. Describe the increased co-operation and collaboration along the supply chain resulting from the project/event/activity, outlining the role played by each supply chain partner. (10 Marks)

Question 3. Describe, providing supporting evidence, the benefits that have been delivered to producers because of the initiative. (10 Marks)
